ATHLETIC BOOSTER MEETING
May 27th, 2009

CALL TO ORDER

Teresa Black called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm, welcomed all new members and thanked all for coming.

MINUTES

Motion was presented by Debbie Schramm and seconded by Chas McCutcheon to approve the April 15th, 2009 CCHS Athletic Boosters meeting minutes. **MOTION APPROVED.**

TREASURER'S REPORT

The April financials were discussed. The types of checking accounts that the Boosters hold were discussed. There are two main checking accounts. The first is the Main account. It is kept for the fundraising such as concessions which is the primary revenue for that account and contributions from private companies such as the Elks. The second account is the Team Accounts. That is where the fundraising money the teams make is deposited. Net income \$15,000.00 was reported and we our goal was \$10,000. An email has been sent out to the coaches that May 31st is the end of our fiscal year. We will continue to pay outstanding bills till the end of May. No new expenses will be paid out with the exception of summer baseball. If you have an expense that needs to be paid you need to get it to Shari ASAP. The Kroger fundraising will continue to be deposited into the accounts. The main account will pay administrative expenses Other than those items listed, the money in the main account and team accounts will be frozen until the August 4th Levy vote. A motion was presented by Chas McCutcheon and seconded by John Channel to approve the Treasurer's Report. **MOTION APPROVED.**

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Teresa discussed membership. There will be no new campaign for membership until after the Levy vote in August. We will still continue the scholarships for next year regardless of the outcome of the levy. If you want to renew your membership you may do so. We want to build up the scholarship for the incoming seniors. We currently have \$860.00 for next year. Teresa said we will be emailing all on upcoming levy events. There are 100 team leaders who are gathering volunteers. They would like to have 100 teams of 25 people who are unique yes votes. That would give us 25,000 yes votes. The 1st meeting is June 1st at Grove City Nazarene on Hoover Rd. There are several fundraisers for the levy. They are at Coldstone Creamery June 6-9th on Stringtown Rd. They will donate 10-15% of all sales to Citizens for SWCS campaign. Subway in Grove City will donate 10% of sales to the campaign. Flyers in Grove City and Hall Rd locations will donate 20% on June 4th if you mention SWCS. Please go out and support these events. Teresa asked that we should present a Motion for the CCHS Athletic Boosters to endorse Issue 2 on August 4th. The motion was made by Dennis Dew and seconded by Colleen Channel. Motion Approved. Teresa thanked all for their

support while she has been president.
