ATHLETIC BOOSTER MEETING
December 16th, 2009

CALL TO ORDER

Maggie Buechner called the meeting to order at 7:03pm, welcomed all new members and thanked all for coming.

MINUTES

Motion was presented by Charles McCutcheon and seconded by Dennis Dew to approve the November 18th, 2009 CCHS Athletic Boosters meeting minutes. **MOTION APPROVED.**

TREASURER'S REPORT

Maggie discussed the accounts and explained that we had placed money in a CD while we were waiting to see how the levy would turn out and the money is back in both the main account and the team account. A motion was made by Mr. Ross to approve the treasurer's report and seconded by Charles McCutcheon. **Motion Approved.**

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Maggie reported that the 3rd Annual Chili Cookoff will be on Friday January 15th, which is the Westland Game. We will need volunteers to help with this event.

Maggie went to the Elks on Monday this week to receive our check from them in the amount of \$1364.22. The Elks would like this money earmarked for the Pay To Participate Fund. We will start a fund for that .

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

Mr. Ross discussed that the District is in the process of developing a Foundation to assist parents with the Pay to Participate. We will not know how long this will take. It was discussed that corporate sponsors can make donations to Pay to Participate at our school if they make the check out to Central Crossing High School. The money can then be allocated to the students of their choice.

Pay to Participate fees are not coming in as they would like. If fees are not paid by a date in January then the athlete cannot participate in the next season's sports. Coaches will be having conversations with the parents and athletes about this. If payments not made, Mr. Ross will have to step in and discuss with parents. Those parents who have made payment plans already will not be affected by January date.

Postings for Spring Sports have taken place. Softball, Track and Strength and Conditioning are the positions and will interview after 1st of year and hopefully will hire in Mid January. The Fall sports coaching openings will not post until end of January/early February as per the District office. Athletes in Spring sports with a coaching vacancy can train at other loations like the YMCA or open gyms with other teams here at CCHS.

COACHES REPORT

Boys Soccer-Coach McCutcheon stated that we will start open gyms in February for both the boys and girls teams.

Wrestling- Coach McCutcheon stated that they will go to Pickerington North on Saturday

for a Dual Meet. They have a very young team with 3 seniors, 1 junior and the rest sophomores and freshman. The boys have big shoes to fill and are working very hard. He is checking grades each week and they are doing well. He stated they will be looking for kids for the fall and we will work on getting flyers out to the middle school and make visits to see about interest there.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Spirit Wear will be here on Friday and will sell during games outside the gym. Concessions are going well. Parents and coaches showing up and doing a great job. We need more volunteers to help with various things with Boosters. Discussed was getting a one parent from each team to represent the team with Boosters. That way we have a good strong amount of people to work with and get info back to the teams.
